Agenda Item(s):

1. Update on CKLA curriculum adoption and math curriculum for 24-25 school Year.
 - It meets the state's requirements and has been vetted and piloted throughout the district.
2. Update on summer construction
 - It will begin this summer, finish date is unknown.. People will be "buzzed" into the office and then "buzzed into the school. Front door will remain where it is, they will go through an office closet.
3. School year-end testing dates and goals review
 - RISE testing—teachers can start next week, but will probably wait until after spring break. 4 & 5 5th also test on science.
 - ACADIENCE Math & Reading: Window opens April 15th, we start with math in 1st, Kindergarten does their own, then when that is complete, they start reading starting with lower grades to upper grades. Preschool screening coming up. The state isn't requiring the Kindergarten KEEP but the district still wants the data, so they are using it at the end of the year.
4. Year-end activities, WIG skate party, reading carnival, water day, BYU field trips and the purpose of each one

- Made sure this meets with the ethics requirements.
- We have created RISE & ACADIENCE end of year goals, to help give the kids some accountability..
- 80% of kids to be proficient on ACADIENCE and 40% proficient on RISE. We will also include “Pathways of Progress” from ACADIENCE, for kids who made typical growth.
- We have a giant juke box an adult will put the records on and trickle down the hallway, they won’t have names, but the kids can see the records going down the hall and get excited about how many kids are proficient.
- School wide field trip (over 3 days), they will be educational. All grades will go to the Bean Museum, different grades will have different added aspects of their field trip: broadcast center, people & places museum, stadium tour, etc.
- Skate Day for meeting our school-wide WIG of getting 800 Croc Claws, Rock T-shirt theme!
- Reading Carnival for WIG for tickets earned from reading minutes throughout the year.
- Water Day! Not sure about the fire truck yet.

Trust lands will be prepared to go over next time.

Committee Questions/Concerns:

- District vehicles parking in front of recess doors instead of the parking lot, hazardous to the kids.
- Concerns about unknown man on the property yesterday, it was taken care of by police.
- Possible arrows in the parking lot, especially on the museum side to help the flow of traffic. Cars are not all going the same way.
- Remind kids riding bikes and scooters to be careful coming to school crossing streets.
